

WHAT IS SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER?

The latest version of the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM-5) defines substance use disorder (SUD) as occurring when "substance use causes significant problems in someone's life, such as health issues, disability, and/or not meeting responsibilities at work, home, or school."
